
### OUR PROGRAMMES

Our programmes are designed to promote the foundational literacy and learning skills of children in public pre-tertiary schools, leading to improved equitable access to education.

We are on a mission to connect tertiary students and young professionals to provide career guidance, mentorship, and leadership training to pre-tertiary schools in Ghana. In addition, we're nurturing the reading, writing, and STEM skills of children through our iRead iLead Campaign.

#### SUCCESS STORIES

In January 2024, SUGN received LEGO kits from Coderina EdTech Foundation to support the operations of the LitSTEM Leaders programme in three (3) partner schools.



A robotics training session was held at Trinity Model Presby Basic School, Adweso. The session was facilitated by our partners at the Coderina EdTech Foundation.











We commissioned the Hohoe East Library in the Volta Region on Friday, May 3rd, 2024. This is the seventh school to benefit from Deloitte's WorldClass Initiative in Ghana. The library serves three thousand one hundred and thirty-three (3,133) students in the seven (7) schools listed under the Hohoe East Cluster of Schools. We are grateful to Deloitte and all stakeholders and dignitaries who graced this colorful ceremony, including the Volta Regional Director of Education (GES), Mr. Francis Agbemadi.

We commissioned the eighth library under the Deloitte WorldClass Initiative in Ghana on Friday, May 10th, 2024. The library serves three thousand three hundred and ninety-four (3,394) students in the ten (10) schools listed under the Aburi Cluster of Schools in the Eastern Region. In attendance was the Director-General of Ghana Education Service, Dr. Eric Nkansah; the Country Managing Partner of Deloitte Ghana, Mr. Daniel Kwadwo Owusu; the Eastern Regional Director of Education, Dr. Mrs. Ivy Asantewaa Owusu; and the Executive Director of Spring-UP Global Network, among others.

#### LOOKING FORWARD

- Looking ahead to 2025, we are filled with hope and determination to continue sowing seeds of hope into the lives of deprived children.
   Together, we can make a lasting impact and create brighter futures for those who need it most.
- In 2025, SUGN will enhance its monitoring plan for the 10 libraries across 5 regions in Ghana, provided under the iRead iLead Campaign.
- Through extensive stakeholder engagement, we will continue and complete the framework and curriculum development of the LitSTEM Leaders Programme. The programme is designed to complement the libraries by nurturing reading, writing, arithmetic, and creativity skills, and popularizing and demystifying the learning of Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) through activity-based programmes. When operationalised, the programme will contribute to the Ministry of Education's overarching goal to accelerate the enrolment goal of a 60:40 admission ratio of science to humanities students at the tertiary level by 2030, as documented in the Education Strategic Plan (ESP 2018-2030).
- SUGN will also use feedback from past beneficiaries to scale up and improve the Mentor Me Programme (MMP), a school outreach programme that provides a platform for industry leaders, professionals, and tertiary students to offer personalized mentorship, career awareness, and career guidance to learners, helping them make informed career choices on emerging 21st-century opportunities.
- In 2025, SUGN will introduce the Student Ambassadors Programme to recruit more volunteers from various tertiary institutions.
